## **Community Center**

A contemporary 2,000 square foot Community Center, with full kitchen facilities is available for gatherings. A fee and deposit, along with a <u>Community Center Rental Agreement</u>, are required and must be reserved through the Village Hall.

The rental fee is \$175 in addition to a refundable \$175 deposit, once the building is cleaned and inspected. Rental fee includes a digital sign message at no cost for three days. Alcoholic beverages may be served if the Village of Williamsville is named as an "additional insured" on a

Certificate of Insurance.

Not-for-profit fundraisers may rent the facilities at a reduced fee of \$75 with proof of a 501C. Those not-for profits without proof of a 501C will be charged \$100. Not-for-profit groups may rent the facilities for meetings at a reduced fee of \$50.00

Village Board members and full-time employees are allowed one free rental per year. Part-time employees are allowed one half-priced rental per year.
